

Case Study - Barnardo's

Picture Train ran a workshop for family support workers across Barnardo's Children's Centres in Worcestershire. The workshop was designed to demonstrate the Picture Train resource – delivering photography into education – and to explore ways of developing Picture Train to meet the needs of children in the context of the statutory framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).
